

A stylised pine tree

Tall is a suitable name for Jan Forsmark's outdoor bollard light for ateljé Lyktan. In Swedish, 'Tall' is the name for the majestic Scots Pine tree.

The name of the lamp alludes to the enchanted pine forests of northern Sweden, where it was first installed as part of the lighting for Treehotel. The name works equally well in English for this stately bollard light.







Corten steel



Technical specifications

Material	Frame in weatherproof Corten steel with no surface treatment. Protection glass in UV-protected PC.
Installation	Fastened by bolts (4 x M12) in a solid base or on accessorie for 108 foundation or for in-situ casting. Ordered separately.
Connection	Cable (max Ø13 mm) connected to luminaire housing (terminal block 5x2.5 mm ²). Through wiring possible. Straining relief inside luminaire housing.
Diffuser	UV protected clear polycarbonate
Light source	Including LED light source, colour temperature 3000K. 4000K on request. Colour rendering CRI 90. Life time: L80 B50 100 000h.
Light scattering	Asymmetric light for lighting up both pathway and the surroundings.
IK class	07.
Weight	21 kg
Other	Location close to the sea's coastline should be done in consultation with the supplier.
Energy classification	This product contains a light source of following efficiency class Light source with CRI 90 and CT 930/940 - Class E
